"Worship...God" Part II John 4:23-24 By Melvin J. Bryant II

Last week, it was established that the Bible speaks of the "Godhead", and that the "Godhead" is defined as, "the state of being God, Divine Character, Divine in Nature, Deity." (BDAG pg. 452)." We find the WORD "Godhead" which CAN'T be denied, in Romans 1:20 and Colossians 2:8. There is ONE God, *however*, according to the Bible, there are THREE Persons in the Godhead.

- (1) We have the Father: (John 6:27)
- (2) We have the Son (Jesus): (Hebrews 1:8-9) And;
- (3) We have the Holy Spirit: (Acts 5:3-4)
 - The "Godhead" consist of only THREE Persons, and; NO ONE ELSE!
 - The Devil is NOT Deity! The Angels are NOT Deity! Mankind is NOT Deity! The ONLY Persons that is apart of Deity, the "Godhead" is, The Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit! (cf. Matthew 28:19; Ephesians 4:4-6; 2 Corinthians 13:14). The Bible speaks of the Godhead!

I. TRUE WORSHIPERS WILL WORSHIP THE FATHER IN PRAYER (Matthew 6:7)

- A. There were MULTITUDES of people following Jesus, and the Multitude did not only consist of Jews, there were Gentiles in the Multitudes as well!
 - In Matthew 4:25, the Bible tells us, "Great multitudes followed Him (that is, followed Jesus ;-) —from Galilee, and from Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan."
 - Even Galilee is mentioned, and it was prophesied that Gentiles would have that light to shine upon them. (Matthew 4:12-17 cf. Isaiah 9:1-2).
 - The people came from ALL over the place, And; the GENTILES were apart of the Multitudes.
 - Jesus was the light of the World (John 8:12 cf. Ephesians 5:14).
- B. When it comes to "Prayer," we can't offer to God what Jesus didn't command.
 - We can't offer to God what Jesus did NOT teach! (Matthew 6:7-9).
 - When Jesus was teaching the Multitudes, He commanded men, whether you were a Jew or a Gentile to PRAY saying, "Our Father in heaven..."
- C. Jesus Disciples asked Him to teach them how to Pray. (Luke 11:1-2).
 - When God sent forth His Son, He gave Him commands and told Him to teach these things to men. (John 12:49-50).
 - When the disciple asked Jesus to "teach them to pray", Jesus said, "When you PRAY, say: "Our FATHER in heaven...." IDENTIFYING who we need to address first in our prayers!
 - Those who promote the idea that we can pray to Jesus would argue that;

II. PAUL PRAYED TO JESUS

A. And, since Paul prayed to Jesus, WE have the right (by way of example) to PRAY to Jesus as well. (see 2 Corinthians 12:8-9).

 - Who can argue with this? (1) Verse 8 tells us that Paul "Pleaded" with the Lord, and the Lord here is referring to Jesus. And; (2) Verse 9 tells us that the Lord ANSWERED Paul and said, "My Grace is sufficient for you, for My Strength is made Perfect in weakness."
 - However, here is where we are to disagree with those who hold this position about praying to Jesus!

First: Notice 2 Corinthians 12:1 in CONTEXT! "IF" Jesus taught Jews and Gentiles how to "Pray" (Matthew 6:9), and His disciples how to Pray, (Luke 11:1-2), then told His disciples in Matthew 28:20 when going into all the world to make disciples, and after men have become disciples Jesus said, "Teaching them to observe ALL things that I have commanded you…" this would be a contradiction if we can "Pray" to God the Father, Jesus, AND; the Holy Spirit as some are advocating!

- 2 Corinthians 12:1, (1) In the a-clause, he says, "It is doubtless not profitable for me to boast." And (2) In the b-clause, he says, "I will come to **Visions** and **Revelations** of the Lord."
- That word "Visions" is defined as, "an event in which something appears vividly and credibly to the mind, although not actually present, but implying the influence of some DIVINE or Supernatural Power or Agency—'Vision." (Louw, J. P., & Nida, E. A. edition., Vol. 1, p. 444)."
- And, "Revelations" is defined as, "to cause something to be fully known—'to reveal, to disclose, to make fully known, revelation." (Louw, J. P., & Nida, E. A. Vol. 1, p. 338)."
- God allowed Paul to SEE things in Visions and revealed Revelations to him.
- What was the Vision and Revelation Paul saw? 2 Corinthians 12:2-6 explains to us! The "Vision" is in verses 2-3, and the Revelation is found in verse 4!
- By the time we get to verse 7-10, Paul explains that a thorn was given to him lest he should be exalted above measure by the ABUNDANCE of the Revelations he received from God!"
- So, YES, Paul "Pleaded" with the Lord, Jesus regarding the thorn!
- And, YES, the Lord answered Paul and spoke directly with him!
- Now, notice Jude verse 3.
- There are some things we are to keep into consideration because the church was still in its infancy stage and there were MANY things of a miraculous nature going on then as appose to now! <u>For Instance</u>:
- Acts 1:24-26, the Apostles PRAYED to the Lord and the Lot fell on Matthias. (Please note: The Lord can also be a reference to God the Father.)
- Acts 7:56, Stephen saw the Lord standing on the right hand of God.
- Acts 9:1ff, the Lord met AND spoke to Paul on the road to Damascus!
- Acts 9:10-15, the Lord spoke to Ananias in a Vision!
- Acts 10:9-15, Peter has a Vision and communicated with the Lord!
- Acts 10:19, the Holy Spirit SPOKE to Peter!
- Acts 18:9-10, the Lord SPOKE to Paul in the night Vision! And guess what? NONE OF THESE THINGS ARE HAPPENING TODAY! (cf. 1 Corinthians 13:8-13)
- The signs of miracles were only to confirm the word! (Mark 16:20).
- \bullet We have NO NEED for confirmation of the word, it is complete. (James 1:25 cf. Jude 3).
